All Saints' Day is a holy day of the Catholic Church on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven. **Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, Nov 1st at St. Jude at 5pm and at St. George at 7pm.**

The **Book of Remembrance** will be in the gathering space through October. Please enter the names of your dearly deceased. You may attend the **Commemoration of the Dead Evensong** at St. George 7:00 PM on **Nov. 2 Wednesday**. We will pray for those in the book and those we lost this year from both parishes.



The correct date for the Mass of Commemoration of the Dead is All Soul's Day, Wednesday, November 2nd.
